E.1045-2 (KIA-38036): Coarse linen on the wrist; E.1045-3 (KIA-38037): Fine linen on the hip; E.1045-4 (KIA-38038): Second tunic; E.1045-5 (KIA-38039): Third tunic; E.1045-6 (KIA-38040): headpiece so-called "bourrelet"; E.1045-7 (KIA-38041): Thread attaching the "bourrelet" on the textile on the right shoulder; E.1045-9 (KIA-38043): "Guirlande": reed bundle placed under the back of the mummy; E.1045-10 (KIA-38044): Fringe of the pillow under the head; E.1045-11 (KIA-38045): Sewing thread of the pillow (KIA-38044); E.1045-13 (KIA-38047): Textile on the right shoulder suggesting a "mantelet"; E.1045-14 (KIA-38048): Fabric wrapped around the left ankle; E.1045-16 (KIA-38050): Threads on the right side of the mummy; E.1045-17 (KIA-38051): Stuffing of the pillow; E.1045-18 (KIA-38052): Fringe of the pillow under the feet of the mummy; E.1045-19 (KIA-38053): Fringe of the linen fabric under the mummy.
